**WINTER - COMPULSORY**

Grey blazer - regulation pattern. School badge available from office

Grey kilt - regulation pattern

Navy V neck jumper - regulation pattern

Long sleeve blue check blouse - regulation pattern

Navy socks. Black or navy tights. **No other colour may be worn**

Sensible shoes in brown, black or navy. **No boots and no high heels**

Royal blue overall for art and science with name on left chest

Grey purse belt. Girls must not leave money or valuables in the cloakroom

**Optional**

Plain grey gloves. A plain grey, black or navy scarf or school scarf

Navy wax jacket - regulation pattern

**SUMMER - COMPULSORY**

Navy skirt - regulation pattern

Short sleeve summer blouse - regulation pattern

Navy V neck jumper - regulation pattern

Grey blazer - regulation pattern. School badge available from office

Navy or white socks. Neutral, black or navy tights. **No other colour may be worn**

Royal blue overall as for winter

Sensible shoes in brown, black or navy. No open-toed sandals and no high heels.

**GAMES - COMPULSORY**

Grey skirt, 2 blue aertex shirts for gym and games

White gym shoes **with white soles only**, white sports socks

Royal blue swimsuit - regulation pattern and royal blue and white bathing cap

Navy school sweatshirt may be obtained from Mrs Margetson in school

White tennis skirt and blouse (summer term only)

Navy blue shoe bag - regulation pattern.

**Optional**

Plain navy blue track suit bottom - regulation pattern

Navy and white cagoule and navy and white hockey shirt available from Mrs Margetson in school

**YEAR 11 AND SIXTH FORM**

Navy track suit, white trainers with white socks and plain white T-shirt

**RULES**
