


Emojis are a universal language in the digital world, used by children and adults alike to express emotions, reactions and humour. However, while most emojis are harmless, some have been repurposed in online communities to convey hidden or even harmful messages. In misogynistic and incel spaces, specific emojis can be used to reinforce harmful ideologies, belittle women or incite harmful behaviour. Other emojis are linked to discussions about drugs, sex or even self-harm. By staying informed, keeping conversations open, and encouraging digital literacy, parents and educators can empower young people to navigate online spaces with confidence and awareness.





EMOJIS WITH HIDDEN MEANINGS: WHAT PARENTS AND EDUCATORS NEED TO KNOW



Emojis are very often playful and harmless, but they can also be used as a tool for exclusion, manipulation and the spread of harmful ideologies. It's important for parents and educators to be aware of these alternative meanings - but also to remember that context is everything. Just because a young person uses a 📞, doesn't necessarily mean they are talking about sex. Similarly, whilst the @emoji is sometimes used in misogynistic spaces as a demeaning representation of women, its appearance on your child's phone might be entirely innocent – perhaps a reference to Halloween or simply a way of expressing frustration.

It's also important to remember that emojis can be used in culturally specific ways, and what means one thing to one group of people, may mean something entirely different to another.

Just because a child or teen uses a certain emoji does not necessarily mean they are engaging with harmful ideas and not every use of a 'coded' emoji is sinister. However, if you notice certain emojis being used frequently or in combination, this could suggest a coded message. The key is to approach the issue with curiosity rather than immediate alarm, staying calm, curious and non-judgemental.


