Duke opens new sixth form centre

The Duke of Westminster was the guest of honour as Francis Holland School opened its new sixth form centre.

The Old School House is a neo-gothic building that joins the school's existing site at 39 Graham Terrace, but also has its own dedicated entrance on Ebury Street.

The £3.5 million renovation hopes to offer the perfect environment for young women to transition from school to university, with the interior design and atmosphere based on a creative workspace or modern university building, rather than a traditional school.
