WINNER: Lady Carole Bamford

Carole Bamford has been a champion of sustainable, conscious living for decades. Driven by a conviction that humans need to live and work in harmony with nature, and concerned about the impact of pesticides and chemicals on the environment, she began turning her family farm organic in the 1970s.

Today, Daylesford Farm sets ambitious annual targets to reduce its environmental footprint, carbon emissions and waste. Meanwhile, the Daylesford Organic and Bamford brands are built on organic farming, natural clothing and well-considered beauty products, while promoting craftsmanship, traditional skills and natural living.

Beulah's beautiful clothes are made using many planet-friendly policies. These include using ethically-sourced wool that minimises CO2 emissions; organic cotton, which is produced with far less water and energy than traditional cotton; bio-viscose, an ethical alternative to viscose; and 100 per cent recyclable packaging.

PCSO Zack Slaney joined the Knightsbridge and Belgravia safer neighbourhood team in 2002 and has been an integral part of the community ever since. He gives talks in schools, visits religious institutions to offer support and reassurance, provides crime prevention advice to residents and is a regular presence at fetes and fairs.
