- Architecture Challenge* for Year 7


*some students will not take part in Architecture Challenge due to timetable constraints.

Young Film Academy: Make A Film In A Day!




Lights, camera, action!

Note: This will only be for Year 7. Due to timetable constraints, some Y7 groups will not do this workshop.



Have you got what it takes to be HIRED?


We've all seen the TV show, but do you think you could impress our very own Sir Alan Sugar with your business idea?

Can you solve the crime?


Welcome to CSI Belgravia - you might have to lift a finger (print)!

STAGE MAKEUP




Lights, Camera, Perfection!
